The demands of home learning on Year 7 students can be immense, especially at a time when they are getting used to their new school – new teachers, new subjects, new people, having to move around the school, learn new routines...

With this in mind, we are introducing Year 7 to home learning slowly. Each half term the number of subjects will increase and the amount of time spent on each subject will also grow.

Students will be asked by most of their teachers to keep their student planner on their desk all lesson and record home learning in it when set; teachers will then check that this has been done. We ask that parents/carers to sign planners to confirm that home learning has been seen. This is also a good way of communicating with your child's tutor.

Key Stage 4: Years 9, 10 and 11

- All subjects (both core and options) will set **45 minutes** of home learning per week; this may include research, reading, note-taking or completing coursework
- English, Maths and Science are taught in sets and home learning will be set on the same night, regardless of class or teacher
- All other subjects are timetabled as Option Blocks and this is where the subjects French, Spanish, Geography, German, History, Drama, Business Studies, Media Studies, Dance, Catering, Music, Graphics, Resistant Materials and ICT are taught.
- Citizenship/RE home learning will be set as appropriate by the teacher.
- When setting home learning, we ask teachers to give a minimum of 48 hours until it is due in – this means that there is always time to seek help if your child becomes stuck or needs extra help.
